


# Center Step Card (Landscape) Tutorial


## Supplies:

- 1 sheet cardstock in required colour
- Pieces of cardstock and/or DSP for decoration
- Stamp Set
- Double sided tape or other adhesive



## Preparation:

- Cut cardstock in half longways. You will now have a piece of cardstock  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Place cardstock  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " in from short edge and cut from 1" to  $5\frac{1}{4}$ ". Turn cardstock over and repeat on the other side.
- Score from the edge of the cardstock to the cut at 1", 2" and  $5\frac{1}{4}$ ". Do this on both sides.
- Score between the cuts at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- The solid line in the following image indicates where to cut the cardstock. The dotted lines are where to score.



- Make mountain folds on the score lines at 1",  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " and  $5\frac{1}{4}$ ". Make a valley fold on the score lines at 2".
- Decorate as desired.

# Center Step Card (Portrait) Tutorial



## Supplies:

- 1 sheet cardstock in required colour
- Pieces of cardstock and/or DSP for decoration
- Stamp Set
- Double sided tape or other adhesive

## Preparation:

- Cut cardstock in half. You will now have a piece of cardstock  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by 11".
- Place cardstock 1" in from short edge and cut from 1" to  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Turn cardstock over and repeat on the other side.
- Score from the edge of the cardstock to the cut at 1", 2" and  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Do this on both sides.
- Score between the cuts at  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "
- The solid line in the following image indicates where to cut the cardstock. The dotted lines are where to score.



- Make mountain folds on the score lines at 1",  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make a valley fold on the score lines at 2".
- Decorate as desired.
