



Bridge Fold Card (IMPERIAL)

Folds flat 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " X 6"



Supplies:

- Card Base: 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " scored as above
- Strip for images: 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " scored 3/8" from each end on the long side. (Use 1 or 2 strips depending on design of card)
- 'Bridge' piece for across front: 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 6"
- Layers:
 - 7 7/8" X 4 1/8" for front background
 - 3 3/8" X 4 1/8" for back of card

Instructions:

1. Take the larger layer, stamp background as desired, cut 2 x 1 1/8" pieces from each end. Attach the 5 pieces to the card base taking care to add them in the order of the design.
2. Stamp / decorate the smaller layer and attach to the centre back of the card base.
3. Burnish all score lines well.
4. Attach the strip / strips to the card base. These are the cross pieces used to attach the embellishments.
5. Add embellishments to the strip / strips either directly or on small strips of acetate
6. On the 'bridge' piece, cut a curve from $\frac{3}{4}$ " up to 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Emboss if desired. Attach to card base.
7. Add embellishments to 'bridge' piece.
