Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Petal Palette (145788)
- **Card Stock** – Smoky Slate (131291); Basic Black (121688); Berry Burst (144249); Tranquil Tide (144252); Whisper White (106549)
- **Stamp Pads** – Berry Burst (144083)
- **Misc.** – White Embossing Paste (141979); Silver Embossing Paste (145646); Whisper White Organza Ribbon (145590); Pattern Party Decorative Masks (144103); Sweet Soiree Decorative Masks (145643); Dimensionals (104430); Leaf Punch (144667)

Measurements:

- Smoky Slate: 8½" x 5½" scored at 4¼" (21cm x 14.8cm scored at 10.5cm)
- Basic Black: 4" x 5¼" (9.5cm x 13.8cm)
- Berry Burst: 3 15/16" x 5 3/16" (9.2cm x 13.5cm); ½" x 5¼" (1.2cm x 13.8cm)
- Tranquil Tide: 2½" x 2½" (6cm x 6cm)
- Whisper White: 2¾" x 2¾" (7cm x 7cm); 2½" x 3/8" (6.5cm x 1.7cm); 4" x 5¼" (9.5cm x 13.8cm)

Petal Palette Silver Embossed Rose

Instructions:

1. Use the Diamond Pattern mask from the Pattern Party Decorative Masks and White Embossing Paste on both pieces of the Berry Burst cardstock. Allow to dry.
2. Use the Rose mask from the Sweet Soiree Decorative Masks with Silver Embossing Paste on the small piece of Whisper White cardstock. Allow to dry and then fussy cut the rose.
3. Punch out 2 full leaf shapes and 2-part leaf shapes using the Leaf Punch on the Tranquil Tide cardstock.
4. Adhere the Berry Burst cardstock to the Basic Black cardstock. Attach ribbon around the lower edge and tie a knot in the centre of the front.
5. Adhere these layers to the front of the Smoky Slate cardstock.
6. Add the leaves to the back of the rose and attach the rose to the front of the card using Dimensionals.
7. Stamp a sentiment from Petal Palette on Whisper White cardstock using Berry Burst ink. Cut a banner on the right-hand side and attach the panel to the rose and card front using Dimensionals.
8. Attach the strip of Berry Burst to the large piece of Whisper White and adhere to the inside of the card.
