

# Itty Bitty Christmas Faux Leather



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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Itty Bitty Christmas (150513);
- **Card Stock** – Real Red (106578); Whisper White (106549); Shaded Spruce (147006)
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- **Misc.** – Wrapped in Plaid Designer Series Paper (DSP) (149596); Christmas Layers Dies (150654); Stitched Nested Labels Dies (149638); Dimensionals (104430); Dark Real Red Stampin' Blends (147934); Crumb Cake Ink Refill (121029); Snowfall Accents Puff Paint (150691); Sponge Brayer (141714)

## Measurements:

- Real Red: 8½" x 5½" scored at 4¼" (21cm x 14.8cm scored at 10.5cm)
- Whisper White: 4" x 5¼" (9.5cm x 13.8cm) for the inside  
2 pieces each 2¾" x 4" (7cm x 10cm)
- Shaded Spruce: 2¾" x 4" (7cm x 10cm)
- DSP: 3" x 5½" (7.5cm x 14.8cm)

## Instructions:

1. Faux Leather piece:
  - a. You will need to work quickly with this as it will dry quite quickly.
  - b. Shake the Puff Paint well and put about 1" (2.5cm) circle of it on a silicone mat or piece of baking paper.
  - c. Add one drop of Crumb Cake ink refill and mix well.
  - d. Add to sponge brayer and roll on to one of the small pieces of white cardstock.
  - e. Heat set to activate puff paint and give some texture.
  - f. Die cut with the third largest of the nested labels.
  - g. Stamp sentiment with Memento Tuxedo Black ink and dry with heat tool.
2. Die cut the mistletoe sprig from the other small piece of white cardstock and from the Shaded Spruce cardstock. Colour the berries on both the white and Spruce pieces with the Real Red Stampin' Blends.

3. Cut the white sprig and attach to the faux leather piece. Add to the front of the card with Dimensionals.
4. Cut the Spruce sprig. Attach part of it to the large white piece and add to the inside of the card. Attach the other part of the sprig to the front of the envelope.
