

Very Versailles 3D Shadowing Grape Heather



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Very Versailles (149275)
- **Card Stock** – Thick Whisper White (140490); Soft Sea Foam (147012); Highland Heather (147010); Gorgeous Grape (147011)
- **Stamp Pads** – Craft Whisper White (147277); Sahara Sand (147117); Highland Heather (147103)
- **Misc.** – Layering Ovals Dies (141706); ¼" Gorgeous Grape Mini Striped Ribbon (146940); Aqua Painter (103954); Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Thick Whisper White: 11" x 4¼" scored at 5½" (29.7cm x 10.5cm scored at 14.8cm)
- Soft Sea Foam: 3⅞" x 5½" (9cm x 14.8cm)
- Gorgeous Grape: scraps (scalloped ovals)
- Highland Heather: scraps (ovals)
- Ribbon: 4" (10cm)

Instructions:

- Art panel:
 - Stamp script image on Highland Heather with Sahara Sand ink.
 - Stamp the leaf spray over the script image with Highland Heather ink.
 - Stamp the leaf spray slightly offset to the Highland Heather image with Whisper White ink to create a 3D / shadow effect. (See note below).
 - Die cut with the second largest oval.
 - Die cut Gorgeous Grape with largest scalloped oval and attach the art panel to it.

- Stamp sentiment on Highland Heather with Highland Heather ink and die cut with the smallest oval.
- Die cut Gorgeous Grape with the smallest scallop oval and attach the sentiment panel to it.
- Take the Highland Heather ink pad and use the direct to paper method and drag down both sides of the Thick Whisper White card base. (Make sure that the Highland Heather ink stripes are wide enough so that there won't be any white showing when the Soft Sea Foam layer is added.)
- Use the Aqua Painter with some Highland Heather ink to add splatters on the Soft Sea Foam panel.
- Attach the ribbon towards the base of the Soft Sea Foam panel. Cut off the edges or wrap them around it.
- Attach the Soft Sea Foam panel to the centre of the card base.
- Add art panel and sentiment panel to the card front using Dimensionals.
- Stamp inside and envelope with script and leaf spray images.

Notes on 3D / Shadowing:

- By stamping your image twice, you can create a shadow or 3D effect.
- Ink your image with coloured ink and then stamp on card stock. Without re-inking, stamp the image slightly off from the original image.

OR

- Ink your image with coloured ink and then stamp on card stock. Stamp the same image in a very light or white colour slightly offset to the first image.
