
Pop Up Block Card

CARDSTOCK:

Cutting Instructions:

- 1. Start with a sheet of A4 cardstock (29.7cm x 10.5cm which is 11-11/16" x 8½").
- 2. As each piece is cut, mark it with a pencil.
- 3. With the long edge at the top of the trimmer, cut a piece 4½" wide. Put aside for now. THIS IS FOR THE CARD BASE.
- 4. Keep the remaining cardstock in the trimmer and cut a piece 3¼" wide. Put aside for now. THIS IS FOR PANELS 2, 3, AND 4.
- 5. Turn the remaining cardstock and cut a piece 3¾ wide. THIS IS FOR PANEL 1. Discard the rest of the cardstock
- 6. Take the card base and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " off the long side so that it measures $\frac{4}{4}$ " x 8".
- 7. Take the Panels 2-4 piece:
 - Cut a piece 3¼' off the long side. This will give a 3¼" square for PANEL 2.
 - Cut a piece 2¾" off the long side. Turn and cut down to a 2¾" square for PANEL 3.
 - Take the remaining piece and cut down on long side to a 2½" square for PANEL 4.
- 8. Take the Panel 1 piece and cut down to a 3¾" square.

Scoring Instructions:

- CARD BASE: score on the long side at 1¼"and 2½".
- PANEL 1: score at 1", 2\%" and 3\%".
- PANEL 2: score at ¾", 2" and 2¾".
- PANEL 3: score at ½", 1¾" and 2¼".
- PANEL 4: score at ¼", 1½" and 1¾".

Designer Series Paper:

- Cut a piece of DSP 5-5/8" wide x 4-1/8" long.
- Cut into 5 strips each 1-1/8" wide x 4-1/8" long.
 Use a pencil on the back to note the order for the pattern.
- STRIP 1: leave as is.
- STRIP 2: cut ¼" off both the top and bottom.
- STRIP 3: cut ½" off both the top and bottom.
- STRIP 4: cut ¾" off both the top and bottom.
- STRIP 5: cut 1" off both the top and bottom.
- OPTIONAL: Cut two more strips of DSP 6" long by 3" wide. These are for the back of the card and the envelope.

Neutral Card Stock:

 Cut a piece 5¼" wide x 4" long for the back of the card

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
