

# Trifold Angle Card




## Supplies

- Base cardstock: One piece of A4 or letter size cardstock will make two trifold angle cards. See diagrams below.
- Layering cardstock: Again, one piece of A4 or letter size cardstock will provide layers for two trifold angle cards. See diagram below.
- Sample uses Stampin' Up!® products: Night of Navy and Basic White cardstock, Let's Set Sail stamp set, Night of Navy, Crumb Cake, Pumpkin Pie inks and Sailboat Builder Punch.

## Instructions

1. Score at 9.9cm (3½") on the long side.
2. Fold on score line and then fold card back to create the trifold.
3. Burnish all scores well.
4. Decorate layers and attach.
5. The diagram below gives measurements for three layers – front and two inside layers. On this sample I only used layers on the outside and right hand inside.

## Trifold Angle Card - Layers



To cut the layers piece, firstly cut the diagonal then each of the panels.  
There will be a 0.5cm (¼") border around each panel when layered onto the card base.  
If you want smaller or larger borders, adjust the height and width accordingly.
